

Guidelines for Establishing and Funding ENOTHE EXPERT Groups

ENOTHE supports and promotes Occupational Therapy and Occupational Therapy Education throughout Europe. ENOTHE will stimulate and facilitate collaboration between European Occupational Therapy educational programmes **and relevant stakeholders** by supporting the establishment of EXPERT groups.

❖ CHARACTERISTICS

Expert Groups are initiated by ENOTHE board alone or in collaboration with COTEC and/or ROTOS

Work on themes concerning OT-EU, i.e.

- Developing ENOTHE as an organisation
- Developing collaboration between ENOTHE and COTEC
- Responses to European initiatives and policy that impact Occupational Therapy and Occupational Therapy education.
- Reviews of Occupational Therapy and Occupational Therapy Education practice.

❖ FUNDING

Funding will be provided for groups that are commissioned by ENOTHE within the framework specified by the ENOTHE board.

The amount of funding is discussed in the board and allocated dependent of the estimated budget. For reimbursement use ENOTHE expense claim forms which must be submitted within 3 months of the meetings.
