

## Guidelines for Establishing and Funding ENOTHE Student Project

ENOTHE supports and promotes Occupational Therapy and Occupational Therapy education throughout Europe. ENOTHE will stimulate and facilitate collaboration between European Occupational Therapy educational programmes **and relevant stakeholders** by initiating the establishment of student project groups.

### ❖ CHARACTERISTICS

Student project groups are mainly initiated by the ENOTHE board.  
They are processed under supervision of OT teachers of member institutions.  
Project may be undertaken in the scope of Bachelor/Master/PhD thesis.

### ❖ RELEVANCE OF TOPICS & OUTCOMES

### ❖ FUNDING

Funding will be provided within the framework specified by the ENOTHE board. In general, funding aims at supporting one student for travelling and accommodation (1 night) to participate at the Annual ENOTHE meeting.  
For reimbursement use ENOTHE expense claim forms which must be returned within 3 months of meetings taking place.

### ❖ TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To write a final report summarising the outcomes and results
- To present results during the Annual Meeting ( Workshops or presentations)

### ❖ PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

Applications to be submitted to the ENOTHE office by two specific deadline dates. The current deadline will can be found at the end of the document and on the website. The application should contain the following information, as found in the document:

3. Teachers supervising.
4. Students involved
5. Objectives/Outcomes
6. Methodology and Workplan
7. Relevance & Impact to ENOTHE and European policies
8. Estimated Costs
