For this demanding position, we require a university qualification (PhD/dissertation) and training in Occupational Therapy. You are also required to have demonstrated knowledge and experience in applied research, funding and in teaching. You have acquired third-party funds for research and development projects and you are familiar with the Swiss health and care systems. Furthermore, you have an excellent knowledge of both German and English, which you are happy to apply effectively, including in scientific publications.

In your capacity as manager, you will promote your employees, think in an entrepreneurial manner and address challenges in leading research in a solution-oriented fashion. You are a good, convincing communicator and you have intercultural competence and great commitment.
