

HANNEKE VAN BRUGGEN LECTURE GUIDANCE NOTES
Closing date for nominating a speaker for the HVB Lecture is 1st May 2017

The HVB Lecture was created at the 16th Annual ENOTHE Meeting at Stockholm, Sweden, in honour of Hanneke Van Bruggen then, the outgoing Director of ENOTHE.

In creating the Hanneke van Bruggen Lecture, the ENOTHE board wished to recognise and honour Hanneke Van Bruggen for her unending dedication and outstanding work in promoting occupational therapy in Europe and internationally.

Regulations Hanneke van Bruggen Lecture

The Hanneke van Bruggen Lecture will be held once a year during the ENOTHE Annual Meeting and will be awarded to an Occupational Therapist working in Europe.

Procedure

The candidate will have to be nominated by at least two member institutes. (See nomination form for details).

The proposers will write a statement of support for their nomination and send in detailed Curriculum Vitae of the nominee.

The nominee will have to sign a declaration of agreement that they are willing to be nominated.

The ENOTHE Board will use the following criteria to decide on the Hanneke van Bruggen lecturer:

- *Focus on and impact for Occupational Therapy
 - *The European perspective
 - *Diversity in local, national or international context
 - *Span over the triad of education, practice and research
 - *The relevance to society
 - *Innovation in occupational therapy education or occupational science
- The lecture should address at least some of the above mentioned topics.

The travel expenses and two nights of accommodation will be paid by ENOTHE.

The candidate will be notified by the Board by the 20 May 2017.

The lecture will be delivered on Saturday 28 October 2017.
