Occupational Therapy Programme of First Faculty of Medicine in Prague (Charles University), Occupational Therapy Programme of European University Cyprus and University School of Nursing and Occupational Therapy of Terrassa (Autonomous University of Barcelona), together in collaboration with ENOTHE and SPOTeurope, are pleased to announce the 1st edition of the international Student Summer course in Occupational Therapy.

The topic of this online course will be “**Digital perspectives on Occupational Therapy education**”. The aim is to provide students, knowledge and skills about digital and innovative solutions that are relevant for Occupational Therapy practice.

The current pandemic we are facing has brought multiple health and social challenges to our society. Occupational Therapy can be a force of change to incorporate and adapt technology at many different levels: from providing virtual interventions to managing occupational deprivation in those individuals facing isolation.

Considering competences that will be important in the future, this course will be focused on the technological and therapeutical aspects of digital solutions for Occupational Therapy practice. The course will follow an evidence-based approach, as well as recollect the best practices in the field.

Through lectures with European experts in the field, discussions and practical sessions, our mission is to contribute to the development of OT competences, including critical reasoning and the ability to create change and incorporate technologies in OT practice, all whilst delivering an excellent service to society.

This course will facilitate a unique intercultural dialogue and experience for Occupational Therapy students.

Alongside, a variety of activities will be proposed and led by SPOTeurope to forge a



sustainable network.

Throughout the different course sessions, students will:

- discover the different digital solutions that are available;
- know how to use the different technologies;
- learn how to work in multidisciplinary technological teams;
- reflect on the ethical aspects of the therapeutic use of technology;
- learn how to develop therapeutic relationships within the virtual environment;
- learn how to adapt evaluations and interventions, within the virtual environment, to work with different clients, groups and populations.

This course is intended to complement occupational therapists' academic studies from all three cycles of OT education levels.
